### Simply Ringz

I started learning making stainless steel inlay rings at the beginning of 2021. This is very precise and meticulous work done by hand and takes a lot of time. Using stainless steel, tungsten carbide, and ceramic (titanium carbide) as a ring core, and locally and responsibly sourced natural stones and material (sand, milky quartz, clear quartz, Kwihi wood, and granite), and bello (lab created) opal as inlay I make handmade rings that are beautiful, stylish, durable, made in ARUBA rings for everyone to enjoy.

I started out making these because I love working with my hands, and I love making jewelry. It has turned in to so much more than that. I have come to learn that you (my costumers) absolutely love what I do. It has become my way of making YOU happy.

I make ringz using either a stainless steel, ceramic, or a tungsten carbide core using different types of material as inlay. You can always ask for a custom order. I can use your own material that has sentimental value or you can choose from the material I have at hand. I do not use cremation ashes as inlay.

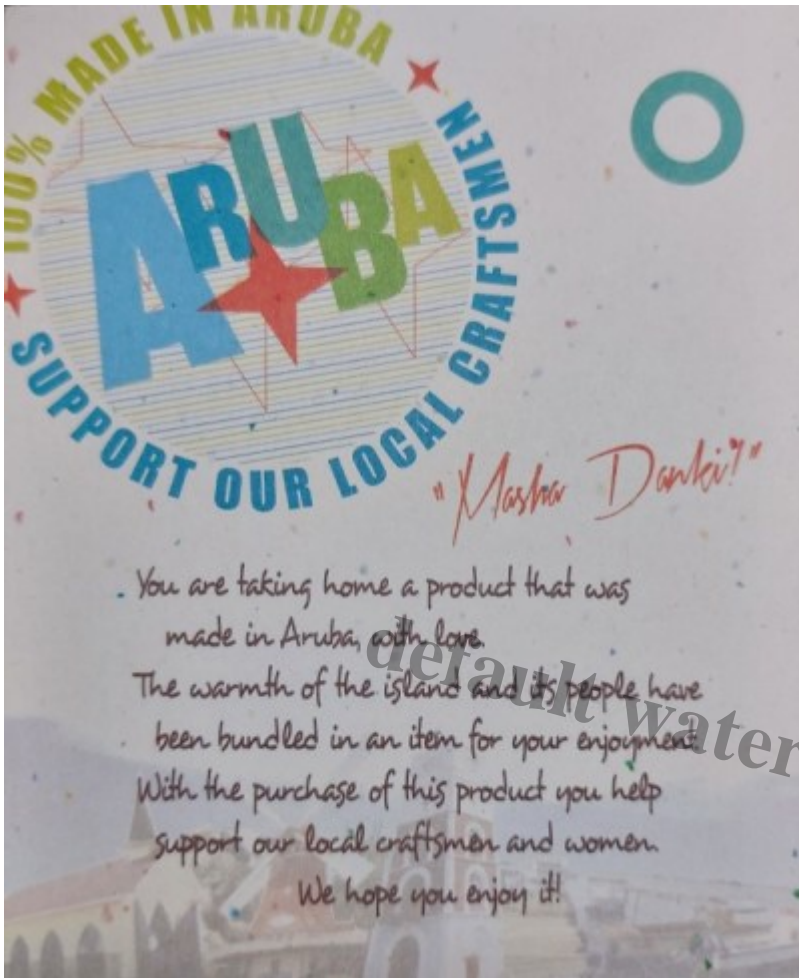
I also make earrings, bracelets, necklaces, and anklets. These are made of stainless steel with any type of inlay I have.
