Frequently Asked Questions

- **Where to find me and/or my jewelry?**

Wednesday April 16, 23, and 30 I will be in the Ola Gallery 10 am to 12 pm

Every Sunday I'm at the Ola Gallery 5-10pm

?My jewelry is available at the Ola Gallery daily.

Mon-Sat 10am-2pm and 5-10pm

Sun 5-10pm

The Ola Gallery is at the Paseo Herencia mall at Palm beach. The gallery is right under the escalator.

- **Location Ola Gallery Sundays 5 to 10pm**

Every Sunday you can find me at the Ola Gallery 5 to 10 pm

- **Can we schedule a meetup?**

I used to do this but at a lot of hotels the security guards told me that this is not allowed. If you really cannot make to Ola Gallery when I am there (Sundays and Wednesdays) and you really want to meet me we can schedule a meetup on another day in the Ola Gallery. Please contact me for this.

I will bring my samples with me, which are not for sale. I can then take your size and your order and will get to work making your order and ship it afterwards.

If you want to take your order home with you, please contact me beforehand so we can schedule a meet up and delivery date ahead of time so I can make this happen.

At the moment there is a 3 week waiting list so please contact me before you come to find out if it is possible to schedule this

- **Do you have a shop?**

I don't have a shop but Cunha's Nosey Parker at Moomba Beach sells my studs

My Jewelry is available at Ola Gallery at Paseo Herencia mall at Palm Beach.

- **Do you ship?**

Yes, I ship world wide and it costs only \$10

- **Can I order now and have it delivered/pick it up when I get there?**

Yes you can! You will get the option at checkout.

Always contact me to if I can get it done for when you get here because most of the time I have a 4 week long waiting list.

- **Do you accept Credit Card?**

Yes I Accept Credit Card. There is a 5% credit card fee for credit card payments

- **What is the price range of your jewelry?**

My rings range from \$90 to \$200 depending on what material ring you want and how much work the inlay takes to do. Most of my rings are \$125

The accessories range between \$20-\$100

- **When will my order ship?**

I mostly take 3 to 5 days to finish an order but this really depends on how many orders I have at that moment and how many days/weeks you are here. At the moment my waiting list is 4 weeks and growing. It will take 4 to 6 weeks before I mail out your order

Everything is handmade to order by me so it can sometimes take longer. I want to give you a perfectly finished product and sometimes things do not go as planned. So when ordering some patience will be required. I mostly finish the orders in the given time frame but sometimes I am just not able to, and I will communicate with you when I cannot finish your order on the delivery date and time we agreed upon.

- **Do you have necklaces, bracelets, anklets, charms?**

Yes I do. You can find them and their prices on the website.

- **How do I find my ring size? And what happens if I get my ring size wrong?**

- **What is the range of ring sizes? Do you make half sizes?**

I have sizes 4 through 14 (sometimes 15 and 16)

Yes I make half and even quarter sizes.

- **How do I take care of my ring (jewelry)?**

- **What can you tell me about the durability of your jewelry?**

Like any jewelry if you treat your piece with care you will enjoy it for a very long time. So if you hit your hand everywhere, operate heavy machinery, and expose your ring to harsh chemicals it will tarnish the inlay. So the better you take care of your ring, the longer you will be able to enjoy it.

- **What material do you use for the ringz?**

For the ring cores I use stainless steel, ceramic (titanium carbide) or tungsten carbide. Neither of them tarnish and all are hypo allergenic.

Stainless steel can bend if you operate heavy machinery; tungsten and ceramic don't. Stainless steel can get scratched if you do not take care of it; tungsten and ceramic won't.

For the rest of the jewelry I use stainless steel which is non tarnish and hypoallergenic

- **What material do you use for the inlay?**

[Inlay Material](#) I use an industrial strength Cyano Acrylate glue (Bob Smith Industries), and Uv Resin (Alumilite) to seal the inlay with.

As inlay material I mainly use sand, Aruba quartz mixed with colored pigments, Kwihi wood, and Granite. These are all native to Aruba. [Click here for more information on this](#)
